10:00 – 12:30 BUSINESS SUMMIT: INDUSTRY BREAK-OUT SESSIONS (PARALLEL TRACKS)

TRACK 1 "Innovation Session: How to stay innovative? Start-up success and beyond"

TRACK 2 "Smart Cities of Tomorrow: Transforming cities through innovative and sustainable solutions"

Both Sweden and Korea have been successful in developing innovative and sustainable cities, applying digitalisation, connectivity and circular economy in the fields of mobility, energy, and security.

<u>Purpose:</u> Position Swedish companies and solutions as innovative global leaders and to share success cases of smart cities in Sweden and discuss collaboration areas in Korean city development.

<u>Intended audience:</u> Providers/users of transport, energy, security and connectivity solutions, cities and municipalities, relevant ministries, citizen organisations, associations and universities

TRACK 3 "Smart Manufacturing: Manufacturing innovation with AI to ensure competitiveness"

Korea is one of the frontrunners of the technological developments within manufacturing. The country has a high dependence on manufacturing, together with globally-leading connectivity infrastructure.

<u>Purpose:</u> Position Swedish companies and solutions as Innovative global leaders. Share Swedish and Korean solutions and discuss how we ensure that AI and innovation is used to move our manufacturing in t he right direction.

<u>Intended audience:</u> Providers/users of factory automation and information system, companies in manufacturing industry, relevant ministries, institutes and associations.

TRACK 4 "Life Science & Healthcare: A new era in digital healthcare powered by AI"

The tremendous potential of Al's application in healthcare is surging, and its possibilities are far beyond providing simple assistance to medical professionals. Key challenges remain as the evaluation and approval of novel Al medical products will need to be supported by clear regulatory frameworks.

<u>Purpose:</u> Position Swedish companies and solutions as Innovative global leaders. Bring together industry, public sector and academia in a partnership and share insights from Korean and Swedish leading experts within the field.

<u>Intended audience:</u> Providers/users of digital healthcare, AI and healthcare innovation, hospitals, governments and municipalities, regulators, insurance, and universities

"Strategic competitiveness through innovation & AI"

Rapid technological advances in Artificial Intelligence (AI), analytics and automation are having, and will inevitably continue to have, profound implications for business, for the economy, and more broadly, for society. This session invites triple helix actors from both Sweden and Korea with the purpose of sharing leading cases between the two countries and exploring how complementary strengths between the countries can be used as a lever for enhanced innovation and growth.

<u>Purpose:</u> Share leading cases between Korean and Swedish industry. How do we ensure that our industries stay in the forefront of innovation, and how will Al impact this? How can Korea and Sweden jointly leverage our respective areas of strength to drive and enhance innovation and sustainable development?

VISIT 1 HOW DID K-POP CONQUER THE WORLD?

K-pop, a global phenomenon and now a multi-billion-dollar industry, has become the international face of Korea thanks to an extremely regimented, coordinated production system. More than any other international music industry, K-pop has been strategically designed to earworm its way into your brain and to elevate Korea and its culture onto the world stage. The visit to one of the top K-pop stars producers will explore how the experts create a K-Pop stars and manufacture incredibly successful products.

Visit to one of the top entertainment studios in Korea, JYP Entertainment and listen to a presentation of their business and strategy for global outreach.

- Get inside a K-pop factory; how to create a K-Pop star for the global market
- Get insights into the exchange between Sweden and Korea in the content industry
- See one of the content studios' own products perform (TBC)

VISIT 2 THE RISE OF A KOREAN UNICORN

Woowa Brothers operates the leading food delivery app in South Korea called 'Baedal Minjok'. The food delivery tally in Seoul is as big as in a few cities in Europe combined. It is mainly because Seoul is a megacity with a population of nearly 10 million. The company has been investing in artificial intelligence and autonomous driving technology to develop delivery robot. How they did evolve from a simple food delivery service to the country's No. 1 app-based food delivery service operator?

Visit to one of the recent Unicorn companies, Woowa brothers (the company behind Korea's leading food delivery app) and PUBG (one of Korea's largest video game developers)

- Get insights into how Korea's leading food delivery app evolved from a simple delivery service to the country's No. 1 app-based food delivery operator
- Learn about Krafton/PUBG, with the international hit game "BattleGrounds"

VISIT 3 CONGLOMERATE POWER: KOREA'S SECRET WEAPON

"Chaebol", a group of massive, mostly family-run business conglomerates, dominates Korea's economy and wields strong influence over its politics. These powerful entities played a central role in transforming what was once a humble agrarian market into one of the world's largest economies. At a time of global economic crisis, they are the ones that should play a strategic role to defend the status and influence of the Korean economy. Delegation will visit one of the top five South Korea's mega-conglomerates (Samsung, SK, Lotte, Hyundai, and LG), represent approximately half of the South Korean stock market's value, to learn the inside of their global success and future vision.
